Here is some additional info for two items on the upcoming Council Agenda. Thought this might help having prior to the discussions:

Agenda Item 4 -- Distribution of Basket Raffle Proceeds from AC&C 2012

Some additional ideas [Council minutes Jan 29, 2011] which could be included in the suggestions for consideration:

- purchase barbershop music & donate it to a local high school
- host a high school or collegiate guest night
- spearhead a youth quartet
- pay travel expenses to send a Harmony youth member to IC&C
- give a scholarship to HITS to a young woman
- teach a class on barbershop harmony at a local middle or high school
- have young girls come to an all-day rehearsal where they learn a song...and perform onstage in a chapter show in the evening (funds could purchase music, buy lunch, etc. for the girls)
- design a young women's track for a future ABC Day

Item 8 -- Proposal for Outside Vendors at AC&C

Currently, any revenues from having vendors at AC&C [booth space rental and/or percentage of sales] would go toward the AC&C bottom line -- not solely to the Hostess Chapter. Of course, the bottom line profit from AC&C eventually gets split between Area 2 and the Hostess Chapter, but the Hostess Chapter's profit is currently limited to \$1,000.
